MRS PRATT ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND THE ARTS (MS BLIGH) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the asbestos replacement program which outlined the first 70 schools to have roofs replaced in 2005-06—

Will she name all schools in the Nanango Electorate with asbestos roofs and the year each will be replaced?

ANSWER:

The Asbestos Roof Replacement Program is a 10-year initiative to replace all roofs containing asbestos in state schools. Roofs will be prioritised according to age and condition.

All state schools in the Nanango Electorate with asbestos roofs are detailed in the table below. This table also details roofs scheduled for replacement in the 2005-06 program. The remaining asbestos roofs will be replaced over the remainder of the 10-year program.

Linville State School	Within 10-year program
Taabinga State School	1 roof in 2005-06 – balance within 10-year program
Toogoolawah State School	1 roof in 2005-06 – balance within 10-year program
