

**Question on Notice

Asked on 7 June 2005**

QUESTION:

MR LEE asked the Minister for Environment, Local Government, Planning and Women (Ms Boyle)—

What is the estimated number of visitors annually to each of Queensland's national parks?

ANSWER:

The State's total annual visitation to all parks is estimated at 16.2 million. The most popular parks in Queensland, are Barron Gorge and Noosa National Parks, each with approximately 1.5 million visits per year. Fraser Island is the most popular camping destination in the State, with over 106,000 camper nights and 800,000 visits from both independent visitors and commercial tour operators.

The number of visits is derived from a combination of data sources for independent day visitors, campers, tourists on commercial tours and estimated visits to Marine Parks.
