Mr Caltabiano asked the Minister for Education and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) -

QUESTION:

For each school in the electorate of Chatsworth (reported separately), will he provide details of total funding in the 2006-07 Budget for (a) capital works, (b) special maintenance and (c) information technology upgrades?

ANSWER:

There are eight state schools in the Chatsworth Electorate. The details of the planned Capital Works and Special Maintenance funding for each of the schools is provided below:-

In relation to Information Technology Upgrades site assessments and scope of work for the 2006/07 ICT Programs have not been finalised. Therefore, the total funding for individual schools within the electorate of Chatsworth, or any other electorate is not available at this time.

In addition, schools also may receive funding from other sources for the upgrade of information technology at a school's own discretion.
