Ms Jones asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION:

How much money has the State Government spent in the Ashgrove Electorate to ensure the Prep Year is in place at all schools, including construction costs, next year?

ANSWER:

The amount of money spent on schools in the Ashgrove electorate to ensure the Prep Year is in place at all schools next year is \$2,501,680. The breakdown per school is as follows:

ASHGROVE STATE SCHOOL

\$589,166 for a new two classroom building, toilet facilities including one disabled toilet, minor refurbishment of one existing preschool, playground relocation/replacement and a curriculum resource establishment grant.

ENOGGERA STATE SCHOOL

\$24,217 for minor refurbishment of one existing preschool and a curriculum resource establishment grant.

HILDER ROAD STATE SCHOOL

\$192,874 for major refurbishment of two existing classrooms and a curriculum resource establishment grant.

OAKLEIGH STATE SCHOOL

\$454,530 for a new one classroom building, minor refurbishment of one existing preschool and a curriculum resource establishment grant.

PAYNE ROAD STATE SCHOOL

\$45,495 for minor refurbishment of two existing preschools and a curriculum resource establishment grant.

THE GAP STATE SCHOOL

\$1,195,396 for a new two classroom building, a new one classroom building, toilet facilities including one disabled toilet, playground relocation/replacement and a curriculum resource establishment grant.
