- (1) What plan does his department have to upgrade the current infrastructure for all emergency services located in Tin Can Bay?
- (2) What is the current level of staffing for all emergency services located in Tin Can Bay?

- (1) The construction of a replacement Auxiliary Fire and Rescue station and a replacement Ambulance station at Tin Can Bay are included as projects on the interim Strategic Infrastructure Plan.
