**MR LINGARD ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TOURISM, FAIR TRADING AND WINE INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT (MRS KEECH)—**

With reference to the Division of Liquor Licensing—

- (1) Will she provide by region (reported separately) the total number of persons detected for using one of the 18+ data cards incorrectly distributed by Queensland Transport as part of the 2005 Schoolies Pack, to enter/attempt to enter a licensed premises and/or consume liquor as a minor?
- (2) For each of the cases in (1) what is the level of penalty imposed (reported separately)?
- (3) For each of the cases in (1), was there a prosecution and penalty imposed on the licensed premises; if so, will she provide these details (reported separately for each licensed premises)?

**ANSWER:**

I am advised by the Liquor Licensing Division of my Department that, to date, no persons have been detected attempting to use false identification made from the Card 18+ application templates which were inadvertently distributed by Queensland Transport prior to last year's Schoolies festivities.
