QUESTION:

With reference to the "head to Queensland" campaign launched by her in March 2006 —

Is the Queensland Government paying for any departmental employees or contractors to attend the Commonwealth Games in Melbourne as part of the strategy; if so, what is the anticipated cost to Queensland taxpayers?
