QUESTION:

MR FOLEY asked the Minister for Environment, Local Government, Planning and Women (Ms Boyle)—

With reference to my letter to her regarding residential land along the Mary River which is to be resumed because of a proposed subdivision and as this land is stable because of riverbank vegetation, has no commercial value as it floods approximately two times per year and there is no access to it because of steep rocky cliffs either side of the flood plain strip of approximately 500 metres—

As people use this purely for vegetable gardens and recreation, will she reverse this decision?
