QUESTION:

With reference to applications for special purpose disability housing from residents of the Jacana Acquired Brain Injury Centre at Bald Hills –

- (1) How many applications have been received within the last three financial years and for the current year to date?
- (2) How many applications were approved?
- (3) Of the applications approved, how many applicants were unable to take up the offer of housing because of the lack of other community support services?

ANSWER:
