

**Question on Notice

MRS E CUNNINGHAM asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Ambulance Station at Gladstone –

For the past three financial years on a year by year basis, what funds have been expended in maintenance on the station and for what repairs, upgrades or replacement was the expenditure made?

ANSWER:

\$105,219 has been expended on maintenance on the Gladstone Ambulance Station over the past three financial years as follows:

- 2003/04 - \$21,117;
- 2004/05 – \$30,102; and
- 2005/06 - \$54,000 (year to date).

The maintenance carried out over this time includes:

- replacement of floor covering (carpets/vinyl);
- repainting interior of building;
- installation of lattice work and security screens;
- refurbishment of the kitchen;
- refurbishment of the toilet block;
- installation of a toilet for persons with disabilities;
- replacement of windows;
- construction of a new driveway;
- refurbishment of the laundry;
- general maintenance to steps and front landing; and
- replacement of the roof (currently underway).
