MRS E CUNNINGHAM asked the Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for State Development, Trade and Innovation (MS BLIGH) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the hardwood buy-back announced in Parliament during the week ending 22 April 2006 and indeed to any decisions regarding cessation of mill supplies —

Are any mills affected in the electorate of Gladstone; if so, which mills and how many jobs will be affected?

ANSWER:

There are no mills in the Gladstone electorate that have a Crown hardwood allocation drawn from the Western Hardwoods Region, and so no mills in the Gladstone electorate have had an allocation reduced due to the Western Hardwoods Plan.

No mills in the Gladstone electorate have been considered for purchase by the Queensland Government through the Western Hardwoods Buyback Process.
