Question on Notice No. 644 Asked on 9 May 2006

MR MALONE asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

QUESTION:

With reference to Question on Notice No. 318 in relation to his departmental capital works program in which it was revealed that expenditure to date for the proposed new Emu Park Ambulance Station was only \$133,000—

- (1) What was the agreement reached between the department and the local stakeholder?
- (2) When is the project expected to be completed?
- (3) Of the \$133,000 expended to date, will he provide the details of this expenditure?

ANSWER:

- (1) Agreement was reached regarding such matters as master planning for drive-through access and future expansion, sharing driveways and sharing use of other parts of the site.
- (2) I refer the member to my previous response to Question on Notice 318 asked on 8 March 2006.
- (3) The expenditure includes fees for design consultancy and other specialist services such as site survey and geotechnical investigations.
