

**Question on Notice
No. 693
Asked on 10 May 2006**

MR ROGERS asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

QUESTION:

With reference to ambulance services in Redcliffe – Will he advise, listed by month and code type, from December 2005 to date (a) the number of call-outs and average response times for each call-out type (recorded separately) and (b) the number of call-outs which have by-passed Redcliffe to Royal Brisbane Hospital due to the Caboolture Hospital Emergency Department closure?

ANSWER:

(a) I refer to the table below:
