**Asked on Wednesday, 10 May 2006**

MR QUINN asked the Minister for Public Works, Housing and Racing (MR SCHWARTEN)-

**QUESTION:**

- (1) How many QFleet vehicles are currently used by Queensland Public Service employees for after hours/personal use – broken down by Government department, type of vehicle and value of vehicle (reported separately)?
- (2) Of these QFleet vehicles, how many are part of salary packages?

**ANSWER:**

- (1) The number of QFleet vehicles currently allocated to individual Queensland Public Service employees for after hours/personal use is detailed in the attached table.

The average value of vehicles in this list is \$44,319.

- (2) Of these QFleet vehicles, all are part of salary packages and as such are subject to Fringe Benefits Tax and Reportable Fringe Benefits Assessment reporting in accordance with the Fringe Benefits Tax Assessment Act.
