MR LANGBROEK asked the Minister for Public Works and Minister for Housing (MR SCHWARTEN)-

QUESTION:

With reference to the Portfolio of Racing -

How many Queensland Thoroughbred Incentive Scheme (QTIS) added stakes races for two and three year olds have been programmed at metropolitan level over the last five years (detailed separately) and how much money has been paid in QTIS added stakes over the same period (detailed separately)?

ANSWER:

Under the *Racing Act 2002*, the control body for thoroughbred racing in this State has the responsibility of managing its code of racing, including the allocation of prize money.

Consequently, any questions in relation to prize money should be directed to Queensland Racing.
