MR FENLON asked the Minister for Health (MR ROBERTSON)-

QUESTION:

With reference to the Health and Community Care Program –

Will he list the funding allocated under the program to non-government HACC service providers within the Greenslopes Electorate for 2005?

ANSWER:

The Home and Community Care Program (HACC) is a national joint Australian and State Government funded program. It provides a range of basic maintenance and support services which allow people to be more independent at home and in the community. HACC eligible clients are the frail aged, younger people with disabilities and their carers.

Funding for the HACC program is allocated for financial year periods, not by calendar year, and as such the funding details are provided for the 2004-2005 financial year and the 2005-2006 financial year.

The total funding allocated under the program to non-government service providers within the Greenslopes Electorate for the 2004-2005 financial year was \$4,355,209, and for 2005-2006 financial year was \$4,669,722. This includes those providers that provide local services within the electorate and service providers located in the Greenslopes electorate that have statewide service responsibilities.

The breakdown in funding for the local non-government service providers and statewide non-government service providers is as follows:

1. Local non-government service providers located in the Greenslopes electorate were allocated operating funding in the 2004-2005 financial year of \$2,106,700 and in the 2005-2006 financial year non-government service providers were allocated \$2,289,985; and
2. Statewide non-government service providers located in the Greenslopes electorate were allocated operating funding in the 2004-2005 financial year of \$2,248,509 and in the 2005-2006 financial year they were allocated operating funding of \$2,379,737.

Attached is a list of each service provider and annual operating funding within the Greenslopes electorate.
