# Asked on 23 May 2006

MR CALTIBIANO asked the Minister for Transport and Minister for Main Roads (Mr Paul Lucas) –

## QUESTION:

Will he provide details of all sponsorships (by event/company/club/activity) both monetary and in-kind for each year reported separately from 1998-2006 for each of the units of administration under his direction such as Main Roads, Queensland Transport, Queensland Rail, various port corporations and any other sponsorships?

## ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Chatsworth for the question.

The Transport Portfolio (including Main Roads) is large and complex with a strong regional presence interacting with a diverse range of stakeholders and clients. As the Honourable Member is aware the portfolio comprises the Government Owned Corporations of Queensland Rail and seven Port Authorities operating 16 ports. The portfolio is a significant employer across both regional and rural Queensland and plays an active role in supporting local communities.

It is an abuse of the process of Questions on Notice to expect the portfolio to have to collate and document every minor sponsorship or donation (monetary or in kind) that may be provided to local community organisations. Likewise the Departments and Government Owned Corporations are members of professional bodies. In their operational activities, they also attend, display at and sponsor professional conferences and seminars and public exhibitions from the RNA down.

For the period 2005-06 expenditure, information is being collated on sponsorships and the Honourable Member is welcome to ask a further question. In addition, portfolio details for 1998-99 to 1999-2000 are no longer available as the information has been archived under the 7 Year statute of limitations for accounting records. Tracking down the appropriate archive storage venues and then searching for the appropriate hard copy items would be extremely labour and time intensive and come at a significant cost to the portfolio.

I am advised that the following items of expenditure have been incurred for amounts over \$5,000 in any one year period.
