MR SEENEY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR NATURAL RESOURCES, MINES AND WATER (MR PALASZCZUK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the proposed dams at Traveston on the Mary River and Tilley's Bridge near Rathdowney in the Beaudesert region—

What studies have been commissioned into these dams to date, who has been commissioned to undertake these studies and what are the terms of reference that have been provided (each dam reported separately)?

ANSWER:

As part of the South East Queensland Regional Water Supply Strategy (SEQRWSS), work was commissioned to review dam sites identified within the region in previous studies.

In accordance with the Government's announcements on 26 and 27 April this year, detailed investigations are underway at the Traveston and Tilley's Bridge damsites.
