QUESTION:

MR HOBBS asked the Minister for Environment, Local Government, Planning and Women (Ms Boyle)—

With reference to the dingoes on Fraser Island and the ongoing increase in the number of these animals—

Will she give an assurance that no dingoes or dingo pups have been relocated from Fraser Island to the mainland by the State Government, island visitors/campers/travellers or environmental groups?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service (QPWS) reiterates that no dingoes have been removed from Fraser Island and released on the mainland.

So far as visitors/campers/travellers/groups are concerned, the QPWS has no knowledge of any removal of a dingo to the mainland.
