QUESTION:

With reference to the proposed new Traveston Dam in the Mary Valley—

Will he release a complete copy of all reports currently underway or about to be undertaken in relation to this proposed dam once they are finalised and received by him as the responsible Minister?

ANSWER:

More detailed site investigations are currently underway at the Traveston Dam site. Full environmental impact studies will be undertaken prior to obtaining relevant Commonwealth and State Government approvals. Extensive community consultation will be involved in these study processes and all necessary information will be made available to the public as part of these processes.
