

**Question on Notice

Asked on 24 May 2006**

MR ROGERS asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

QUESTION:

With reference to ambulance services in Redcliffe — Will he advise, listed by month from December 2005 to date

- (a) the number of ambulance staff employed at Redcliffe Station;
- (b) the number of rostered hours worked;
- (c) number of sick days taken; and
- (d) overtime paid?

ANSWER:

- (a) December 2005 – 17 x Paramedics, 3 x Patient Transport Officers and 1 x Officer-in-Charge;

May 2006 – 17 x Paramedics, 3 x Patient Transport Officers and 1 x Officer-in-Charge;

February 2006 – 2,880 hours;
March 2006 – 3,216 hours;
April 2006 – 2,968 hours; and
May 2006 – 3,192 hours.

January 2006 – 13;
February 2006 – 7;
March 2006 – 18;
April 2006 – 2; and
May 2006 – 8.
