MR PEARCE asked the Minister for Health (MR ROBERTSON)-

QUESTION:

With reference to the Health and Community Care Program (HACC) -

Will he list the funding allocated under the program to non-government HACC service providers within the Fitzroy Electorate?

ANSWER:

The Home and Community Care Program (HACC) is a national joint Australian and State Government funded program. It provides a range of basic maintenance and support services which allow people to be more independent at home and in the community. HACC eligible clients are the frail aged, younger people with disabilities and their carers.

Currently Fitzroy receives recurrent operating funding of \$2,657,204. As an outcome of the 2005-2006 HACC funding found, Fitzroy will receive an additional \$53,667 recurrent operating funds and \$271,225 non operating funds.
