MR FRASER asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

QUESTION:

Will he update the House on progress of the construction of the new emergency services complex at Roma Street to serve my electorate of Mt Coot-tha?

ANSWER:

The new Fire and Ambulance Station at Roma Street will provide a modern and efficient Emergency Services Centre with the capacity to serve future population growth of the Inner City and surrounding Western Suburbs, including Mt Coot-tha.

The project was tendered for in September 2005, and the building contract awarded to ADCO Constructions Pty Ltd in early October 2005.

Demolition of the old Roma Street Station commenced in mid October and was completed in January 2006.

All planned construction activities are now proceeding well, with building work progressing above the second level.

The Practical Completion of the project is scheduled for late November 2006.
