Mr SPRINGBORG asked the Premier (Mr Beattie) -

QUESTION:

With reference to the Service Delivery and Performance Commission which was established in October 2005 under the chairmanship of Dr Leo Keliher to assess and improve the performance and services delivered by Government-
As the commission is required to provide quarterly reports, will he table the reports presented to him to date and, in the spirit of openness and transparency, will he provide a detailed outline of the commission's identified savings to date?

ANSWER:

The Service Delivery and Performance Commission commenced on 10 November 2005. As the Commission had to be established and staffed, work on the first three reviews in the Commissions Work Program commenced in February / March 2006.

On 5 April 2006, Dr. Keliher provided his first quarterly report verbally.

The next quarterly report is due in the first week of July 2006 and a written report will be provided at that time.

As the first three reviews have not been finalised, there are no savings identified to date.
