MRS STUCKEY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR NATURAL RESOURCES,
MINES AND WATER (MR PALASZCZUK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the site of the Coolangatta Special School atop Kirra Hill—

- (1) What is the time frame for the Kirra Hill site to be officially gazetted to the Gold Coast City Council (GCCC) as trustee?
- (2) Will there be a security management plan to keep the site secure and what will this entail?
- (3) What were the terms and conditions of the \$30,000 given to the GCCC to use on development of a master plan of the school site?
- (4) Will the State Government be removing the unwanted school buildings (not the main building) prior to handing over the site to GCCC?
- (5) Are there any State Government funds to assist with renovation of the main school building and the removal of the unwanted buildings?

ANSWER:

The question would be best directed to my colleague, the Honourable Rod Welford MP, the Minister for Education and the Minister for Arts, whose portfolio responsibilities cover this issue.
