MR HOPPER asked the Minister for Local Government, Planning and Sport (MR FRASER) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Local Government Loans Program—

- (1) Which councils applied for loans successfully in 2006-2007 and for how much (reported separately)?
- (2) Which councils applied for loans and were unsuccessful in 2006-2007 and how much did they apply for (reported separately)?
