1803 **MS LEE LONG** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH (MR ROBERTSON)—

With reference to the building of the new Children's Hospital on Mater Hill in Brisbane—

- (1) What assurances will the Minister give that the comprehensive, all options genetics/family planning services, currently available at the Royal Children's Hospital, will be continued at the new Children's Hospital?
- (2) What consultation has occurred in relation to the transferring of paediatric cardiac surgery from Prince Charles Hospital to the new hospital and, in particular, was the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons consulted?
- (3) Will the paediatric fragment on its own be viable at the new hospital?
- (4) Has the land to be used for the new hospital on Mater Hill been purchased or will it be leased?
- (5) Will the Minister explain to the people of Queensland, how these decisions were made?
