MR MESSENGER asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE)-

QUESTION:

With reference to the Serious Sexual Offenders Review Committee—

(1) How many offenders were referred to the committee in 2006–07, 2005–06 and 2004–05?

(2) How many were approved for Dangerous Prisoners (Sexual Offenders) Act (DPSOA) applications?

(3) How many of those offenders that were rejected for considerations of a DPSOA order were not subject to a child protection offender register order?

ANSWER:

Serious Sexual Offenders Review Committee:

Matters relating to applications under the Dangerous Prisoners(Sexual Offenders) Act fall within the responsibility of the Attorney General.

Child Protection Offender Registry:

The Child Protection Offender Registry is maintained by the Queensland Police Service and they hold all data and statistics regarding reportable offenders. Specific information regarding offenders who appear on the Child Protection Offender Registry can only be accessed by people authorised by the Commissioner of Police.
