MR LEE asked the Minister for Transport, Trade, Employment and Industrial Relations (MR MICKEL)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide details of State Government support for bus services in Brisbane's western suburbs?

ANSWER:

In 2006/07 the Queensland Government, through TransLink, provided the following service improvements for western suburb bus services:

Route	Description	Date Implemented	Improvement
470	Toowong to Newstead	July 2006	Increased weeknight services.
444	Moggill to CBD	October 2006	Introduced new high frequency BUZ route, to operate every 10 minutes in peak and 15 minutes in off-peak times, 7 days a week.
468	Indooroopilly to Oxley Rail Station	February 2007	Introduced new weekday service.
467	Sinnamon Park to Oxley Rail Station	February 2007	Introduced new weekday service.
412	CBD to University of Queensland - St Lucia	March 2007	Increased services.

In 2007/08 the following improvements are planned for implementation/have already been implemented in the western suburbs:

Route	Description	Date Implemented/ Planned	Improvement
444	Moggill to CBD	July 2007	Increased frequency in morning peak.
402	Toowong Rail Station to University of Queensland - St Lucia	July 2007	Increased frequency.
468	Indooroopilly to Oxley Rail Station	December 2007	Introduce weekend services.
444	Moggill to CBD	Planned for 2008	Divert route onto Inner Northern Busway.
