Ms Stone asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the newly upgraded car park at Kimberley Park State School —

How did the State Government contribute to this project?

ANSWER:

Our Government has had considerable involvement in this project with a view to improving facilities for the school community. The upgrade to the car park at Kimberly Park State School was jointly funded by Logan City Council (50 per cent) and Queensland Transport (50 per cent).

To enable this upgrade to occur, the State Government, through my Department of Education, Training and the Arts, contributed a 725 m² portion of land towards the project which was excised from the school site at a cost of approximately \$56,550.

The costs associated with the resurveying of the site and relocation of the fence was also funded by the State Government at a cost of approximately \$15,000.
