Mr McArdle asked the Minister for Police and Corrective Services (MS SPENCE)-

QUESTION:

Will she advise the numbers of police vehicles and motorcycles assigned and available to each (a) station, (b) district and (c) region in Queensland?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service vehicle fleet currently numbers 2,133 vehicles. The distribution of the fleet can be broken down as follows:-
