

## **Question on Notice**

**No. 430**

**Asked on Tuesday, 13 March 2007**

**MRS SCOTT MP** asked the Minister for Communities, Minister for Disability Services Queensland, Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, Minister for Seniors and Youth (**MR PITT**) -

With reference to disability services in Logan City –

- (1) Which services are funded by the State Government?
- (2) How many clients does each service support?

### **ANSWER:**

- (1) Disability Services Queensland provides funding to the following services located in Logan City:

Youth and Family Services (Logan City) Inc – Logan Youth Connections at Logan City  
Ability Care Limited at Hillcrest  
Lutheran Community Care – Keystone Accommodation Support Service at Woodridge  
Karakan Hostels at Woodridge  
Endeavour Foundation – Kingston ATSS at Kingston  
Multicap – Logan Services at Marsden

- (2) The number of individuals supported by the funded services in the Logan electorate, through both block funding and individualised funding, is as follows:

Youth and Family Services (Logan City) Inc – Logan Youth Connections – 31 clients  
Ability Care Limited – 82 clients  
Lutheran Community Care – Keystone Accommodation Support Service – 10 clients  
Karakan Hostels – 30 clients  
Endeavour Foundation – Kingston ATSS – 24 clients  
Multicap – Logan Services – 44 clients

In addition, some individuals living within Logan City receive support services from other service providers that are located in Brisbane, the Gold Coast and surrounding areas.
