MR DICKSON asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

QUESTION:

What additional fire station facilities are planned for the high growth area of Sippy Downs and has he considered establishing a fire station co-located with the new Sippy Downs police station?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Fire and Rescue Service continually monitors and reviews service demand across the state, allocates resources accordingly and plans for the future.

The Department of Emergency Services is currently in the process of securing land in the Sippy Downs area for future use.

Co-location of emergency services is a consideration in the normal planning process of any future facility.
