Ms Croft asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford)

QUESTION:

What grant funding has been allocated to schools in the Broadwater Electorate to help schools fund special projects to improve facilities?

ANSWER:

Coombabah State High School will receive a grant of some \$40 000 in the next financial year to assist in upgrading its Special Education facilities. This grant will be funded through the Smart Schools' Subsidy Scheme.

In 2006–07 Broadwater schools received the following Minor Capital Works grants:

For the 2007 implementation of the Preparatory year, the following schools received a grant for minor works to be carried out on their existing preschool classrooms:
