With reference to the employment of Aboriginal people under the Community Development and Employment Programme —

For the years 2004-05, 2005-06 and 2006-07 (year to date), how many Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people are currently being employed by State Government departments as subsidised workers through the Federal Government's Community Development and Employment Programme?
