**Asked on 19 APRIL 2007**

MR WELLINGTON asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR PURCELL) -

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the Nambour ambulance staff resources will he advise if, as at 19 April 2007

- (a) There are any staff vacancies at Nambour, and if so how he proposes to fill these vacancies,
- (b) If not, how many hours of overtime have been performed at the station over the last three months, and
- (c) What overtime is expected to be performed over the next three months?

**ANSWER:**

- (a) The Nambour Ambulance Station has a full complement of staff.
- (b) An average of 8.1 hours of overtime has been worked for each rostered working week during this period.
- (c) Overtime is dependent on a number of variables and therefore can't be precisely determined in advance.
