**QUESTION:**

MRS MENKENS asked the Minister for Environment and Multiculturalism (Ms Nelson-Carr)—

Will she supply details for the number of vehicles in the Environmental Protection Agency fleet by (a) make, model and type and (b) fuel type?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for Burdekin for her Question (Number 830).

The Environmental Protection Agency has 530 vehicles in its fleet. Since January 2005, the EPA's preference has been for the use of 4 cylinder fleet vehicles as a standard. However, in complying with whole-of-government policies, QFleet has recognised that the EPA has a requirement for 6 cylinder 4 wheel drive vehicles for operational needs, such as for fire fighting and day-to-day operations on parks.

The EPA has already made great progress towards improving the performance of its vehicle fleet over the last several years. In particular, our trialling and adoption of the Toyota Prius for use throughout the fleet shows that we are open and committed to ensuring we have appropriate and fuel efficient vehicles within our fleet. The Agency currently has 24 of these vehicles incorporated into its fleet both within Brisbane and regionally.

In addition, the leases on Executive vehicles are to be extended from two years to three years to deliver whole-of-government savings. As Executive vehicle leases are turned over, Executives will adopt 4 cylinder vehicles if they utilise the QFleet system.

Details of the Agency's vehicle fleet mix are attached.
