

**Question on Notice

Asked on 5 June 2007**

MRS CUNNINGHAM asked the Minister for Police and Corrective Services (MS SPENCE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to my constituent, Mrs Robyn Hannam, who has asked about the report into the death of her son, Ronald James Hannam (reported in Rockhampton on 29 June 1992) and her family concerns that the report was incomplete as they were advised in January 2007 that the inquiry into his death was closed down because a policeman's son [name supplied to Minister] was involved—

Will she check the records and advise whether this is the case?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service has comprehensively reviewed all available information relating to this matter.

I am advised there is no evidence to support the suggestion that this investigation was closed down due to a policeman's son being involved.

The completed investigation report was submitted to the Coroner, who on 7 July 1992 determined that an inquest was not necessary as the police file did not disclose any suspicious circumstances surrounding Mr Hannam's death.
