DR FLEGG ASKED THE MINISTER FOR NATURAL RESOURCES AND WATER AND MINISTER ASSISTING THE PREMIER IN NORTH QUEENSLAND (MR WALLACE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the water levels at Boondooma Dam—

- (1) What is his department's advice as to the level of the dam at which the water will not be useable by power stations?
- (2) Will he table this advice?

ANSWER:

- (1) According to the Critical Water Supply arrangements, the High Priority water entitlements for power generation ceases when the water level in Boondooma Dam reaches EL 247.2 m AHD.
- (2) Yes
