MR HINCHLIFFE asked the Minister for Local Government, Planning and Sport (MR FRASER) –

QUESTION:

With reference to sport and recreation funding—

What assistance has been provided to sport and recreation organisations over the last 12 months in the Stafford Electorate?

ANSWER:

Since May 2006, in excess of \$1.2M has been approved to provide sport and active recreation opportunities and benefits to residents of the Stafford Electorate, under the Queensland Government's sport and recreation funding programs.

This includes \$1,132,605 under the Major Facilities Program 2007 to Brisbane City Council to construct tennis courts and a club house in Wavell Heights and \$74,975 under the Minor Facilities Program 2006 to Wilston Grange Australian Football Club to develop junior playing fields and install light towers at Hickey Park, Stafford.

There has also been a total of \$9,850 provided to young athletes in the Stafford Electorate under the Young Athlete Assistance Program.
