MR KNUTH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR STATE DEVELOPMENT, EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (MR MICHEL)—

With reference to his press release in April 2007 in which he stated that Queensland continued to “lead the way in promoting clean coal technology to reduce greenhouse gas emissions” and now that the Premier has reversed his decision to support the ZeroGen project –

Will funding allocated to ZeroGen be redirected to other projects; if so, which projects?

ANSWER:

The Department of State Development is not responsible for the funding allocated to the ZeroGen project. The Department of the Premier and Cabinet manages the expenditure of Queensland Future Growth Funding on clean coal technologies.
