Mr COPELAND asked the Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister Assisting the Premier in Western Queensland (Mr Shine) -

QUESTION:

For 2005-06 and 2006-07 (to date) (each year reported separately) -

- (1) How many Queensland District Court criminal trials have resulted in a hung jury?
- (2) How many Queensland Supreme Court criminal trials have resulted in a hung jury?

ANSWER:

- (1) The figures shown below include Queensland District Court criminal trials where a jury could not reach a verdict on at least one charge on an indictment. This includes trials where verdicts have been reached on some charges.
