Mr Copeland asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION: With reference to funding under the national Secondary Schools Computers Funds—

(1) How many secondary schools in the Toowoomba and Darling Downs districts have applied for funding for computers (each school reported separately)?

(2) How many secondary schools in the Toowoomba and Darling Downs districts have been granted financial support from the Secondary Schools Computers Funds in order to purchase additional computers (each school reported separately)?

ANSWER:

Chinchilla State High School, Dalby State High School, Jandowae State School, Pittsworth State High School, Quinalow State School, Tara Shire State College, Centenary Heights State High School, Clifford Park Special School, Crow's Nest State School, Harristown State High School and Toowoomba State High School have all applied for funding under the National Secondary Schools Computer Fund.

All three schools invited to apply in round one in Toowoomba and Darling Downs districts have been granted funding. These schools are Chinchilla State High School, Quinalow State School and Crow's Nest State School.

The Federal Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations is currently assessing applications from Round Two, and has not yet made any funding decisions.
