MS STONE asked the Minister for Communities, Minister for Disability Services, Minister for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships, Minister for Multicultural Affairs, Seniors and Youth (**MS NELSON-CARR**)—

- Will the Minister provide details of funding received by Logan East Neighbourhood Centre Association since 2001?

ANSWER:

Logan East Neighbourhood Centre Association has received defined term funding since 2000/2001 totalling \$587 838.

In addition, on 28 July 2008, the Centre received a one off payment of \$9 091 from the Supporting Neighbourhood and Communities Centre's funding Initiative of the Department of Communities for refurbishment and equipment.

Logan East Community Neighbourhood Association Inc (LECNA) provides the only funded community and family support activities in the 10 east Logan suburbs and provides a wide range of programs in Springwood and the surrounding suburbs, including: budgeting, counselling, job skills, family support, domestic violence support, volunteer training, social groups and play groups.

LECNA has won many awards for community service over the years, in particular the David Steel Australia Day Award in 1994 and 2000 and the Logan City Council Business Achievers Award for Community Service/Non-Profit Organisation for five consecutive years from 2003 to 2007.
