MR WELLS asked the Minister for Emergency Services (MR ROBERTS) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the excellent auxiliary fire station at Deception Bay which has been proposed to be closed when the new fire station opens at Burpengary –

Will he reconsider his department's plans to close the Deception Bay auxiliary fire station?

ANSWER:

The Deception Bay Auxiliary Fire Station will remain operational after the opening of the Burpengary Fire Station.

Building a new fire station on the western side of the Bruce Highway will further enhance fire and rescue services to the community with a permanent crew working twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.
