MS VAN LITSENBURG asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION: Will the older schools in Redcliffe be getting vital maintenance this financial year?

ANSWER:

The following funding has been approved for maintenance works in 2008–09:

Clontarf Beach State High School	\$333,181
Clontarf Beach State School	\$114,996
Humpybong State School	\$179,120
Kippa-Ring State School	\$129,890
Redcliffe Special School	\$ 56,572
Redcliffe State High School	\$216,233
Scarborough State School	\$139,081
Woody Point State School	\$ 99,319
Total	\$1,268,392

These schools will receive funding through the Annual Maintenance Program and Special Maintenance Programs. The funding also includes monies from round one of the \$90m boost for external maintenance from the Tomorrow's Schools program, as announced by the Minister on 9 October 2008.

The funding from the first round of the \$90m boost for maintenance will fast-track works such as external painting and repairs and replacement of wall cladding, roofs, guttering, downpipes, windows, doors, posts, verandahs and staircases.
