MR JOHNSON asked the Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Sport (MS SPENCE)—

QUESTION:

Will she provide details of all police stations in Queensland including (a) the police district and area the police stations are attached to, (b) the hours the police stations are open for enquiries from the public and (c) the number of police officers attached to each station?

ANSWER:

Policing in the 21st century is about being responsive and mobile.

The Queensland Police Service is available 24 hours a day to assist the people of Queensland. This is through public access to stations via front counters and the phone, through the internet and Police Communications centres.

The Queensland Police Service website has a Police Station Locator tool which provides details of all police stations in Queensland.

There are currently 330 police stations, 60 Neighbourhood Police Beats and 49 Police Beat Shopfronts as a part of 30 operational police districts that exist across the State

The 2007/2008 Queensland Police Service Annual Statistical Review contains all district and regional police numbers.
