MR MOORHEAD asked the Premier (MS BLIGH) -

QUESTION:

Will she outline what funding has been allocated to Logan City under the Q150 Program?

ANSWER:

The Q150 program has provided two grants to the Logan City Council.

In 2006, Logan City Council was awarded a \$5 million grant from the Q150 Legacy Infrastructure Program to assist with the construction of an international standard indoor sports and recreation centre to be located on Browns Plains Road, Crestmead. I understand that construction has now started on the \$17 million Logan Metro Indoor Sports Centre which, when completed in 2009, will become the home to the Women's National Basketball League team, Logan Thunder.

In 2007, Logan City Council was awarded a \$10,000 Q150 Community Funding Program grant to research, locate and exhibit documents and images of the region as recorded by 19th and early 20th Century writers, surveyors, photographers and artists. The exhibition will be presented at the Logan Art Gallery from 4 August to 5 September 2009.
