MR DEMPSEY ASKED THE MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS (MR MICKEL) —

QUESTION:

- (1) How many provisional drivers in Bundaberg have received their licence by meeting the 100 hours of supervised driving requirement since the introduction of this option?
- (2) How many Bundaberg drivers used an accredited driving trainer to make up 30 hours of the required 100 hours?

ANSWER:

I am advised :

(1) In Bundaberg (postcode 4670) 147 learner drivers became eligible to apply for, and subsequently obtained their provisional licence after meeting the 100 hours of supervised driving requirement.

(2) Of the above mentioned 147 drivers, 110 drivers used an accredited driver trainer for periods of up to 10 hours as part of the 100 hours of supervised driving requirement.

As you would be aware, every hour of lessons with an accredited driver trainer counts towards three in a learner logbook, representing a maximum of 30 hours of the required 100 hours.
