MS STRUTHERS asked the Minister for Education and Training and Minister for the Arts (Mr Welford) —

QUESTION:

What is the total capital works and maintenance funding that has been approved since September 2006 for (a) Boronia Heights State School, (b) Flagstone State School, (c) Flagstone Community College, (d) Logan Village and (e) Logan Reserve State Schools (reported separately and in each category)?

ANSWER:

The Bligh Government is building tomorrow's Queensland today.

We're delivering world class education and training by providing schools with vital new infrastructure and modernising our older schools to ensure all students have access to quality learning environments no matter where they live.

Our Government will have invested more than \$2.8m on minor and major capital works, refurbishments and maintenance for Boronia Heights State School, Flagstone State School, Flagstone Community College, Logan Village and Logan Reserve State School from September 2006 to the end of 2008-09.

Boronia Heights State School:

The Government will have invested an estimated \$346 363 for Boronia Heights State School.

This includes over \$78 000 for Prep Classroom refurbishment.

Flagstone State School:

The Government will have invested an estimated \$1 041 555 for Flagstone State School.

This includes over \$500 000 for Prep facilities.

Flagstone State Community College:

The Government will have invested an estimated \$271 518 for Flagstone State Community College. This includes over \$160 000 on State Schools of Tomorrow maintenance.

Logan Village State School:

The Government will have invested an estimated \$366 900 for Logan Village State School.

This includes \$42 958 for a disabled access ramp and more than \$117 000 for Prep facilities.

Logan Reserve State School:

The Government will have invested an estimated \$803 352 for Logan Reserve State School.

This includes \$94 795 to rectify drainage issues and more than \$440 523 for Prep facilities.
